Sweet Summer Scents

- _____ **Lavender, Abriellii** *Lavandula x intermedia 'Abriellii'*
Dark Purple Flowers. Excellent fragrance. Shorter than other intermedia selections.
- _____ **Lavender, Allardi** *Lavandula x allardii*
Light Lavender Flowers. Tall, upright growth habit. Good for hot, humid climates.
- _____ **Lavender Alba** *Lavandula intermedia 'Alba'*
Pure White Flowers. Large flower heads on tall, strong stems. Sweetly scented.
- _____ **Lavender, Betty Blue** *Lavandula angustifolia 'Betty Blue'*
Dark Purple Flowers. Taller growth habit than many English cultivars.
- _____ **Lavender, Buena Vista** *Lavandula angustifolia 'Buena Vista'*
Light Purple Flowers With Dark Purple Calyxes. Blooms spring through summer.
- _____ **Lavender, Canary Island** *Lavandula canariensis*
Dark Purple Flowers; Bright Green Foliage. Free flowering Spring through Fall.
- _____ **Lavender, Dutch Mill** *Lavandula x intermedia 'Dutch Mill'*
Medium Blue Flowers. Large flower heads on tall, strong stems work well in fresh cut arrangements.
- _____ **Lavender, Edelweiss** *Lavandula angustifolia 'Edelweiss'*
White Flowers. Large, vigorous plant blooms profusely. Strong, sweet scent.
- _____ **Lavender, English** *Lavandula angustifolia (vera)*
Lavender Blue Flowers. This is the true species English Lavender.
- _____ **Lavender, Fern Leaf** *Lavandula multifida*
Lavender Blue Flowers. Lacey foliage, tridentate inflorescence, and free-flowering habit.
- _____ **Lavender, Fred Boutin** *Lavandula intermedia 'Fred Boutin'*
Violet Flowers. Large, tall plants are reportedly hardy to below 0°.
- _____ **Lavender, French** *Lavandula dentata*
Medium Purple Flowers; Grey Foliage. Vigorous year-round bloomer. Strong camphor scent.
- _____ **Lavender, French Green** *Lavandula dentata ssp.*

Light Purple Flowers; Bright Green Foliage. Vigorous year-round bloomer. Strong scent.

Lavender, Goodwin Creek Gray *Lavandula 'Goodwin Creek Gray'*

Lavender Purple Flowers, Free flowering Spring through Fall. Excellent landscape selection.

Lavender, Graves *Lavandula angustifolia 'Graves'*

Lavender Corollas With Dark Purple Calyxes. Heavy bloomer. Use fresh or dried.

Lavender Grosso *Lavandula x intermedia 'Grosso' syn. 'Fat Spike'*

Medium Purple Flowers. Bred for fragrance and disease resistance. Strong, sweet scent.

Lavender, Hedge *Lavandula intermedia*

Medium Lavender Blue Flowers. Strong, hardy, plants bred for fragrance and disease resistance.

Lavender, Hidcote *Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'*

Dark Purple Flowers. Compact, dwarf plant with short flower stems. Sweetly scented.

Lavender, Hidcote Pink *Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote Pink'*

Pink Flowers. Compact plant blooms heavily spring through summer. Sweetly scented.

Lavender, Intermedia *Lavandula intermedia*

Medium Lavender Blue Flowers. Strong, hardy, plants bred for fragrance and disease resistance.

Lavender, Kew Red *Lavandula stoechas 'Kew Red'*

Violet -Red Flowers with Light Pink to White "Rabbit Ears." Strong, hardy plants bloom year – round.

Lavender, Lady *Lavandula angustifolia 'Lady'*

Bright Lavender Blue Flowers. Fast, but diminutive growth habit. Early bloom and re-bloom.

Lavender, Melissa *Lavandula angustifolia 'Melissa'*

Medium Pink Flowers. Short stems. Lightly fragrant flowers are an excellent culinary selection.

Lavender, Miss Katherine *Lavandula angustifolia 'Miss Katherine'*

Bright Lilac-Pink Flowers. Exquisite fragrance. Mounding growth habit.

Lavender, Munstead *Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead'*

Medium Lavender Blue Flowers. Compact plants are heavy bloomers. Sweetly scented.

Lavender, Otto Quasti *Lavandula stoechas 'Otto Quastii'*

Dark Purple Flowers with 1" Violet "Rabbit Ears". Highly fragrant free-flowering plants will bloom all year with heaviest flowering spring through summer.

Lavender, Pinnata 'Buchii' *Lavandula pinnata 'Buchii'*

Lavender Blue Flowers. Lacey foliage, tridentate inflorescence, and free-flowering habit.

Lavender, Premier *Lavandula angustifolia 'Premier'*

Dark Purple Flowers. Elongated flower form creates an airy appearance.

Lavender, Provence *Lavandula x Intermedia 'Provence'*

Light Purple Flowers. Bred for strong, sweet fragrance. Excellent culinary selection.

Lavender, Provence White *Lavandula intermedia 'Alba'*

Pure White Flowers. Large flower heads on tall, strong stems. Sweetly scented.

Lavender, Rosea *Lavandula angustifolia*

Very Light Pink Flowers. Compact, diminutive growth habit.

Lavender, Royal Purple *Lavandula angustifolia 'Royal Purple'*

Medium Dark Purple Flowers. Excellent cut flowers fresh or dried.

Lavender, Royal Velvet *Lavandula angustifolia 'Royal Velvet'*

Dark Purple Flowers. This long stemmed cultivar holds its color when dried.

Lavender, Sarah *Lavandula angustifolia 'Sarah'*

Medium Lavender Blue Flowers. Petite growth habit.

Lavender, Silver Frost *Lavandula angustifolia x L. lanata 'Silver Frost'*

Deep Violet Flowers. Foliage is one of the most silvery of all lavenders.

Lavender, Sleeping Beauty *Lavandula angustifolia 'Carolyn Dille' syn. 'Sleeping Beauty'*

Dark Purple Flowers. Upright, spire-like growth habit. Heavily scented,

- _____ **Lavender, Spike** *Lavandula latifolia*
 Medium Lavender Flowers. Highly aromatic silver foliage. Tolerant of poor soil conditions.
- _____ **Lavender, Super** *Lavandula intermedia 'Super'*
 Light Violet Flowers. Very large flower heads. Superb essential oil.
- _____ **Lavender, Sweet** *Lavandula heterophylla*
 Medium Purple Flowers. Fastest growing selection. Tall, open, airy habit. Flowers year-round.
- _____ **Lavender, Tuscan** *Lavandula 'Tuscan'*
 Medium Purple Flowers. Dense silver foliage on hardy plants looks great all year long.
- _____ **Lavender, Twickle Purple** *Lavandula angustifolia 'Twickle Purple'*
 Lavender Blue Flowers. Sweet fragrance; good culinary variety.
- _____ **Lavender, White Spica** *Lavandula intermedia 'White Spica'*
 Pure White Flowers. Large flower heads on tall, strong stems. Sweetly scented.
- _____ **Lavender, Woolly** *Lavandula lanata*
 Deep Purple Flowers. Wispy flowering wands stand well above the plants downy soft silvery foliage. Requires good drainage.
- _____ **Lavender, Yellow** *Lavandula viridis*
 Yellow and White Flowers; Chartreuse Foliage. Unusual coloration for a Lavender species. Strong growth habit once established. Provide good drainage. Will re-bloom after cutting.
