# Tomatoes

## Heirloom & Specialty

---

### **Tomato, Abe Lincoln**     *Solanum lycopersicum 'Abe Lincoln'*

This American heirloom tomato from a family farm in Illinois was introduced by the Buckbee Seed Company in the 1920s. These robust indeterminate plants have a natural resistance to disease that rivals the best modern hybrids. Bright red 8 – 16 oz. fruit are borne in clusters of up to 9. The globe shaped tomatoes are juicy, sweet, and mildly acidic. Use fresh in salads, sandwiches, etc. sliced, diced, or wedges.

---

### **Tomato, Aussie**     *Solanum lycopersicum 'Aussie'*

This heirloom from Australia is a winner producing giant 1-2 lb. red tomatoes with that old fashion, bold tomatoey flavor! These indeterminate plants are strong, prolific, and highly disease resistant. The meaty beefsteak fruit will impress the most particular tomato experts. Use fresh in salads, sandwiches, etc. sliced, diced, or wedges.

### **Tomato, Banana Legs**     *Solanum lycopersicum 'Banana Legs'*

Unusually lacey vines with wispy leaves produce bright yellow banana shaped fruit. These unique tomatoes are full of flavor with few seeds and the perfect texture and firmness for sauces and salsas. Determinate variety.

---

### **Tomato, Beauty**     *Solanum lycopersicum 'Beauty'*

Medium sized, highly productive, indeterminate, leafy plant producing a huge amount of 14 oz., slightly flattened pink fruits with big juicy, very sweet but so well balanced with that perfect amount of acid for full, complex tomatoey flavors.

### **Tomato, Better Boy**     *Solanum lycopersicum 'Better Boy'*

Guinness Book of World Records record holder--342 pounds of fruit from one plant! The fruit from Better Boy is deep red and meaty, up to a pound each. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Big Beef** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Big Beef'*

This is a de-hybridized version of an American favorite. These large, juicy, fruits combine old-fashioned beefsteak flavor with heavy yields. 1-pound, round to globe-shaped. Flavor is full and hearty with lots of sweet juice balanced with that wonderful tomato acidity. These giants slice up perfectly for big sandwiches. Fruit stays large even at the end of a long harvest season. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Black Cherry** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Black Cherry'*

A tall, vigorous plant that produces abundant crops of 1", deep mahogany-brown fruits. The only round, truly black cherry. Fruits are irresistibly delicious with sweet, complex, full flavors, characteristic of the "blacks." Beautiful to mix with other cherries. Indeterminate variety

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Black Prince** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Black Prince'*

Originally from Siberia, this is one of the most popular and favored black tomatoes. The Black Prince tomato is said to have considerable health benefits beyond the presence of lycopen. These deep garnet, round, 2-inch tomatoes are full of juice and incredibly rich flavor. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Blue Ridge Mountain** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Blue Ridge Mountain'*

Tall potato-leaf vines bearing 1 lb. pink beefsteaks with good old-fashioned, delicious tomato flavor. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Box Car Willie** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Box Car Willie'*

Named after country western singer Willie Nelson, Box Car Willie produces 10 to 16-ounce, smooth, bright-red with an orange tinge. These excellent tasting tomatoes are very juicy. Good resistance to disease and cracking. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Brandywine** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Brandywine'*

A pink, potato-leaf, Amish variety from the 1880's. It is legendary for its exceptionally rich, succulent tomato flavor. Fruits are reddish-pink, with light, creamy flesh that average 12 ounces but can grow to 2 pounds. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Bull's Heart** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Bull's Heart'*

Old Russian variety that yields, 1 to 2-pound, oxheart-shaped, pink fruit with few seeds and great taste. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Camp Joy** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Camp Joy'*

Heavy bearing heirloom variety that offers an abundance of luscious 1" fruit with huge, well-balanced, sweet tomato flavors. Strong disease resistant. Perfect for snacking or salads. Indeterminante variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Celebrity** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Celebrity'*

Vigorous, disease resistant, high yield and exceptionally flavorful fruit, make Celebrity a winner for gardeners. This mid-early variety will produce under a broad range of conditions. Most genetic resistance of any All America Selection winning tomato. Produces 8oz.flavorful fruit all season long. Determinate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Cherokee Chocolate** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Cherokee Chocolate'*

A rogue heirloom originating from the popular old heirloom from Tennessee, Cherokee Purple, this 4-inch beefsteak variety has developed a great following among celebrity chefs because of its exceptionally rich tomato flavors and wonderful chocolate mahogany color. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Cherokee Purple** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Cherokee Purple'*

This popular heirloom from Tennessee was cultivated by the Native American Cherokee tribe. These very productive plants produce loads of dusky rose to purple colored, 12 oz.-1 lb., beefsteak tomatoes with deep red colors to the interior flesh and dark shoulders. Cherokee Purple is one of the best tasting heirloom tomatoes with rich, complex and sweet flavors. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Delicious** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Delicious'*

This American favorite yields an abundance of scarlet- red beefsteak tomatoes. And, as the name implies, they are delicious! Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Dona** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Dona'*

This excellent variety was bred by the French specifically for their customers in markets, where flavor and quality standards are uncompromising. These slightly flattened, almost seedless, round tomatoes possess a sweet/acid balance that few modern tomatoes can match. The heavily producing plants yield 6 ounce, juicy fruits that are smooth, meaty, and deep-red in hue. Good disease resistance. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Dutchman** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Dutchman'*

This old heirloom beefsteak produces large, pink, oblate, 1-2 lb. sweet fruit with wonderful tomatoey flavors. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Early Annie** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Early Annie'*

This early season heirloom variety produces 3-inch, round, meaty fruits with few seeds. Particularly good for canning. Fruit sets all at once. Determinate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Early Girl** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Early Girl'*

This is one of the earliest maturing tomatoes available. Highly disease resistant plants produce flavorful 6 oz. red fruit that is ideal for serving fresh in salads and sandwiches. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Early Wonder** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Early Wonder'*

This extra-early maturing and compact variety yields an abundant crop of round, reddish-pink, great-tasting fruit. Perfect for impatient gardeners and those in shorter season growing climates! Determinate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Garden Peach** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Garden Peach'*

This is a very pretty novelty tomato. The delicately sweet, 2 oz. fruit has peach colored skin with a hint of red inside. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Gardener's Delight** *Solanum lycopersicum 'Gardener's Delight'*

Also known as Sugar Lump, these red cherries range from 3/4 to 1-1/2 inch across and are loaded with sugary sweet flavor. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Gold Currant** *Solanum pimpinellifolium 'Gold Currant'*

1/2-inch, golden cherries with sweet & tangy flavor. Good acid balance. Great for snacking right off the vine or dressing up any salad! Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Golden Rave Baby Roma**

*Solanum lycopersicum 'Golden Rave'*

This is a baby golden roma tomato that packs the powerful flavor of its full-sized counterparts! Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Green Giant**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Green Giant'*

This tall, bushy, potato-leaf plant from Germany produces large crops of 1-2 lb., lime green, smooth, oblate fruit. Delicious sweet flavors. Arguably, one of the best tasting green tomatoes. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Green Zebra**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Green Zebra'*

The 2-inch round fruit ripens to a yellow-gold with dark-green zebra-like stripes. The flesh is lime-emerald in color that has an invigorating lemon-lime flavor. This is great tomato for brightening up salads and other tomato dishes. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Hillbilly**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Hillbilly'*

This Ohio heirloom beefsteak originally from West Virginia produces huge, 1-2 lb., heavily-ribbed, orange-yellow fruit with red mottled skin and red streaks within. These tomatoes have very sweet, fruity flavors, and are low in acid. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Ida Gold**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Ida Gold'*

Ida Gold has a deserved reputation for very good quality, earliness and flavor. Tough, compact vines yield sets of 2-3 oz fruits even under lousy conditions but they appreciate soil well amended with aged compost. These pretty tomatoes have a sweet, fruity and low-acid flavor. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Julia Child**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Julia Child'*

These tall, potato-leaf plant produce lots of 4-inch, deep-pink, lightly-fluted, beefsteak fruits that have the kind of robust tomatoey flavors and firm, juicy flesh that invites tomato feasting. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Liberty Bell**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Liberty Bell'*

This tomato looks like a red bell pepper and is somewhat hollow, which makes it the perfect choice for stuffed tomatoes! Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Peacevine Cherry**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Peacevine Cherry'*

The fruit of this prolific variety is reputed to produce peace and tranquility.... Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Pineapple**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Pineapple'*

This heirloom garden favorite grows fruit to 2 lbs! The bi-colored, slightly flattened, yellow beefsteak have a red blushing and streaks on the outside. It's yellow flesh contains few seeds and a red star-burst in the center. The taste is wonderfully mild with sweet, tropical fruity- flavors. This is an eye-catcher with taste that will impress the most selective palate!

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Pink Pondeosa**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Pink Ponderosa'*

Introduced in 1891, as the name says, this tomato is big and pink! These rich, meaty tomatoes have few seeds and are excellent slicers. Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Pruden's Purple**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Pruden's Purple'*

Developed from the Brandywine, some say Pruden's tastes even better.... Great for hot day and cool night climate. Large potato leaf vines produce lots of 1-lb., slightly flattened, smooth, purple-pink fruits with few seeds. This tomato has beautiful presentation and exceptional flavor! Indeterminate variety.

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Razzleberry**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Park's Razzleberry'*  
Razzleberry tomatoes are super-sweet, dark pink, juicy tomatoes that will melt in your mouth. This strong disease resistant plant is easy to grow with high yields over a long season. Determinate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Red Currant**      *Solanum pimpinellifolium*  
This is the tiny tomato with the big taste! Easy to grow and highly prolific! Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Salsa**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Salsa'*  
This is the tomato for salsa lovers.... The firm, flavorful fruit holds its shape and succulence with chopping and dicing, and won't water down your salsa , or other sauces. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, San Marzano**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'San Marzano'*  
Best roma -type Tomato. If you want the best for sauces, paste, or sun drying, this is the one to grow. These large roma tomatoes are solid and bursting with bold, complex flavors. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Stupice**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Stupice'*  
Pronounced "Stew-Peach-Ka." This potato-leaf heirloom from Czechoslovakia is a cold-tolerant tomato that bears an abundance of very sweet, flavorful 2 to 3-inch, deep red fruit. Stupice is an award winner for flavor, sweet/acid balance, and production. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Super Snow White**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Super Snow White'*  
Beautiful and very sweet, these 2 oz., ivory-colored tomatoes are perfect for cutting in half to expose the beautiful interior and serving in salads. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Supersweet 100**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Supersweet 100'*  
The natural heir to the throne of 'Sweet 100', 'Supersweet 100' brings new qualities, including long racemes of sweet, juicy bite-sized fruits throughout summer. Also has the essential benefit of verticillium wilt resistance. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Sweetie**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Sweetie'*  
These cherry-size tomatoes are deliciously sweet straight from the vine, tossed in a salad, or served on a platter with other fresh garden delights! Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Vintage Wine**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Vintage Wine'*  
This heirloom variety will be a wonderful new addition to your garden. The bicolor fruit of pink with gold-stripping, pastel-hued, 1 lb. tomato delivers an elegant sweet flavor. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Yellow Brandywine**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Yellow Brandywine'*  
This vigorous potato-leaf heirloom produces large numbers of 3 to 4-inch, yellow-orange, beefsteak fruit. These siblings to the ever-popular Brandywine deliver the same legendary succulent tomatoey flavor. Indeterminate variety.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Tomato, Yellow Pear**      *Solanum lycopersicum 'Yellow Pear'*  
The fruit of this prolific heirloom is like candy from the vine! Bet you can't eat just one.... Indeterminate variety.

\_\_\_\_\_ **Tomatoberry**

*Solanum lycopersicum 'Tomatoberry'*

This specialty tomato produces an abundance of deliciously sweet 1" strawberry-shaped fruit. The bite-size tomatoes make a novel addition to any fresh veggie platter!  
Indeterminate variety.
